Whether you're looking for a **wine-fueled** beachside picnic or a dressed-up dinner followed by DJ sets, Montauk has no shortage of fun new hotspots and must-see classics to add to your **bachelorette itinerary**. Expect daytime rosé runs to the best East End wineries, sunset Champagne toasts at waterfront restaurants, and nights that will likely last later than planned. Where to eat

A fun dinner before a night out, 668 The Gig Shack offers a relaxed atmosphere with top-tier dining options. Locals simply call it "The Shack"—head here for its eclectic, colorful design and surf atmosphere, just off the strip of Montauk's Main Street. For your chicest night on the town, the cutting edge Maverick's Montauk is a sleek and delicious option best reserved for an indulgent sunset dinner. Ideal for splurging on the tastiest pasta, seafood picks (hello, catches of the day), and an extensive wine menu, it is also home to unique and moody coastal views, next to floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking Fort Pond. Watch the sunset and indulge in the raw bar Duryea's (locally well-known, and maker of the \$100 lobster salad). It's an ultra-buzzy location that is open for walk-ins only—so plan for some ample wait-time upon your arrival.
