## East Hampton Historical Society's 19th Annual Antiques & Design Show Benefit With Honorary Chair David Kleinberg



East Hampton Historical Society celebrated its 19th Annual Antiques & Design Show Benefit, a showcase of antiques and mid-century decorative arts for the home and garden, on Saturday, July 12, and on Sunday, July 13. The annual benefit event kicked off with a Preview Cocktail Party on Friday, July 11, at the historic Mulford Farm at 10 James Lane in East Hampton, a fitting venue as a tribute to East Hampton's rich heritage.
